# White



**1. Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi 17.85**

**Classico Piersanti, Italy DOC**

From the famous town of Jesi in the Marche region. A youthful, light and fresh white wine that is dry and zingy on the palate. Presented in the traditional bottle.

**2. Viognier, Domaine de la Baume 19.50**

**France, IGP Pays D'OC**

This classy dry white wine has a lush juicy texture and shows the classic Viognier floral notes.

**3. Waipara Hills Sauvignon Blanc, 19.35**

**Marlborough, New Zealand**

Generous and lifted, showing powerful aromas of nettle and snow peas: the palate bursts with fresh citrus, grapefruit and melon notes.

**4. Sancerre, AC 26.65**

**Les Collinettes, Joseph Mellot, France**

Fermented at low temperatures and aged on its lees up until bottling to keep it fresh, this wine is stylish and racy, with the classic blackcurrant leaf, gooseberry character and mineral finish.

**5. Pinot Grigio 19.75**

**Trentino L'Aristocratico, Italy**

Superb example of this popular grape. Flavourful and expressive with zesty fruit and long lingering finish. Stunningly different from our carafe wine.

**6. Chablis. AC 28.40**

**Paul deloux, France**

The driest white Burgundy from the most northern sector of Burgundy. The wine is fermented and matured without oak to preserve the characteristic flinty style.

**7. Zeller Riesling Feinherb 18.80**

**Peter and Peter, Germany**

Making somewhat of a comeback with wine drinkers bored with the trend of bone dry wines, Riesling is a pure, youthful and citrusy on the nose with a refreshing palate that is off-dry. Complement it with a cheeseboard.

**8. Sauvignon Blanc, 14.85**

**Luis Felipe Edwards, Rapel Valley, Chile**

Hand harvested gently pressed to retain the natural fruit aromas and flavour of citrus fruit, melon, pineapple and pear.

**9. Chenin-Sauvignon Blanc, 15.75**

**Running Duck, South Africa**

This **fair-trade** wine is refreshing, combining the grassiness of Sauvignon with the ripe guava fruit of Chenin Blanc.

**10. Chardonnay, (Unoaked) 14.85**

**Luis Felipe Edwards, Rapel Valley, Chile**

Deliciously fresh, the wine has bright fruity aromas with lovely tropical flavours and balance.

# Red

**11. Merlot, Domaine de la Baume  
'Grand Chataignier', France** **19.50**

A youthful and intense red wine that is mid to full-bodied on the palate with plenty of dark berry fruit, spice and a touch of oak.

**12. Châteauneuf-du-pape,  
Bois de Pied Redal, Ogier, France** **37.75**

Dark fruit flavours such as black cherry and blackcurrant, spiced with liquorice and aromatic herbs; the palate is full-bodied with fine-grained tannins which give it a smooth finish.

**13. Rare Vineyards Malbec,  
Pays d'Oc, France,** **16.85**

Malbec has recently become appreciated by the discerning wine drinker looking for something a little different from the new world and Argentina in particular. However Malbec's home is in the south of France as this velvety, overtly fruity wine with violet aromas and some spice on the palate shows.

**14. Rioja Crianza** **19.95**  
**Fincas de Landaluze, Spain, DOC**

Bramble, dark plum and spicy oak give the wine a lovely aroma. The palate is lush and rich.

**15. Barolo, Terre del Barolo  
Italy, DOCG** **28.45**

This outstanding wine takes its name from the village of Barolo which nestles in the Langhe hills of the Piemonte region, north west Italy. Brick red with a complex, woody nose and a lingering flavour of liquorice on the palate.

**16. Shiraz,  
Running Duck, South Africa** **15.75**

This medium bodied red is soft and spicy with plenty of berry fruit and a hint of white pepper on the finish. **Fair trade** and **organic**? Enjoy with a very clean conscience.

**17. Valpolicella, Classico,  
Ripasso, Italy DOC** **21.50**

Ripasso—Valpolicella which has been passed over the dried grape skins of the great (and expensive) Amarone wine taking on some of its characteristics. Concentrated, chunky and mid bodied with prune and damson notes on the nose.

**18. Chianti Ruffino** **19.85**  
**Italy, DOCG**

When Chianti became a DOCG in 1984, it was a bottle of Ruffino Chianti that wore the first warranty strip bearing the number 00001. Made exclusively of Sangiovese grapes, it shows floral and fruity notes that lead towards spicy scents of white pepper and hazelnuts.

**19. Cabernet Sauvignon,  
Las Ondas, Valle Centrale, Chile** **14.85**

A juicy full-bodied red wine that has plenty of dark fruit on the nose.

**20. Campo Reale Nero D'Avola  
Terre Siciliane, Rapitala, Italy, DOC** **18.95**

Delicious Nero d'Avola from the sunshine island of Sicily. Hand harvested grapes briefly matured in small oak barriques create a wine with a soft silky cherry fruit finish. If you liked our previous Nero d'Avola then this is a definite step up in quality. A must try!

# Rosé

**21. Whispering Hills White Zinfandel, 15.40**  
**California, USA**

Loads of fresh summer fruit flavours and lively acidity. Medium bodied to appeal to most palates, California's own Zinfandel.

**22. Parini Pinot Grigio Rosédelle Venezie, 15.95**  
**Italy**

Soft, coppery pink rosé, delicate and fruity bouquet: soft and fresh on the palate.

# Fizz

**23. Prosecco Extra Dry 19.65**  
**Treviso, Italy**

Becoming ever more popular, Prosecco is clean, dry and crisp with a creamy finish

**25. Louis Dornier et Fils 29.50**  
**Brut, Champagne, France**

A light, fresh vigorously youthful Champagne with a fine, elegant, slightly lemony nose, lively mousse and long crisp palate. Outstanding value and consistently good. There is a high percentage of Pinot grapes (both Noir and Meunier) in the blend.

**24. Taittinger, Brut Reserve NV. 47.40**  
**Champagne, France**

Toasty and biscuity on the nose, with a good weight of fruit in the mouth.

**26. Galanti Spumanté Rosé 19.50**

Light, carnation pink coloured rosé with generous raspberry and strawberry fruit.

# Dessert Wine

**27. Lafleur Mallet, Sauternes**

**37.5cl**

**17.95**

A textbook example of elegant Sauternes, the sweetness perfectly balanced by the acidity. Have with or instead of a dessert.

The perfect accompaniment to cheese boards.

**Italy**

*Clean, fresh and gently aromatic, with hints of both apple and citrus.*

30. **Cabernet Sauvignon,** (500ml)

**Chile**

31. **Zinfandel Rosé,** (500 ml) **9.95**  
**California**

*Medium sweet and bursting with lively summer fruit flavours.*
