


White

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- 1. Between Thorns Chardonnay** 18.85
Australia
- A crisp fruity chardonnay with tropical aromas, followed by flavours of juicy nectarines and peaches and a hint of vanilla.
- 2. Luis Felipe Edwards Macerao** 19.85
Orange Wine, Itata, Chile
- Made from Moscato grapes and produced as an orange wine where the skins and seeds are kept in contact with the juice. Rich and textured with zesty aromas of peach and wild flowers, with a hint of honey.
- 3. Leefield Station Sauvignon Blanc,** 24.35
Marlborough, New Zealand
- Generous and lifted, showing powerful aromas of exotic citrus and woody herbs, the palate bursts with lime zest, pink grapefruit and passion fruit notes.
- 4. Sancerre, Les Collinettes** 32.50
Joseph Mellot, France
- One of the best Sauvignon Blancs in the world. Minerality, maturity, concentration and well balanced acidity. Fermented at low temperatures and aged on its lees up until bottling to keep it fresh, this wine is stylish and racy, with the classic blackcurrant leaf, gooseberry character and mineral finish. **vegan**
- 5. Pinot Grigio L'Aristocratico DOC** 22.85
Trentino, Italy
- Superb example of this popular grape using fruit from vineyards in the foothills of the Alps. This wine has a superbly concentrated, weighty style. **vegetarian**
- 6. Chablis. AC** 31.50
Paul deloux, France
- The driest white Burgundy from the most northern sector of Burgundy. The wine is fermented and matured without oak to preserve the characteristic flinty style.
- 7. Vinho Verde Branco** 18.80
Quinta das Arcas Arca Nova. Portugal.
- The quintessential light wine of Portugal. Memories of alfresco lunches of barbecued fish. Fresh and fruity with a light body, it shows green apple and a soft minerality with a touch of **spritz** on the finish. **vegan**
- 8. Sauvignon Blanc,** 17.85
Luis Felipe Edwards Valle, Rapel Valley, Chile
- A typical, zingy, fresh Sauvignon Blanc with lots of grassy herbaceous aromas and a touch of lime sorbet, melon and passion fruit.
- 9. Chenin-Sauvignon Blanc,** 18.75
Running Duck. South Africa
- This **fairtrade** and **organic** wine is refreshing, combining the grassiness of Sauvignon with the ripe guava fruit of Chenin Blanc. **vegan**
- 10. Bereich Bernkastel, Mosel** 18.85
J Bader, Germany
- A light jasmine and rose scented wine with notes of citrus fruit and pear from vineyards in the Mosel Valley around the picturesque town of Bernkastel-Kues

Wine List

All our wines have been extensively researched by our resident wine buff (and proprietor) to ensure the best quality wines at an unmatched value for money.

Everyone and their dog are currently having supply issues and wine is no exception. With poorer harvests than usual New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc is particularly affected. Wine makers from New Zealand have been lending their expertise to South Africa and some lovely Sauvignon Blancs are coming from there.

*Closer to home we have **Sancerre** from France. A touch more expensive but one of the best Sauvignon Blancs in the world.*

With the difficulties not all our list may be available but we will offer alternatives where possible.

**11. Merlot, Luis Felipe Edwards
Rapel Valley, Chile**

17.85

Bright ruby-red, this unoaked Merlot shows black and red cherry, spicy plum and blackcurrant all wrapped up in the velvety textured palate.

**12. Châteauneuf-du-pape,
Le Clefs du Paradis, France**

38.75

This ruby red wine is very complex, delicate and elegant with aromas of redcurrant, red cherries, leather and tobacco with spicy overtones such as lavender, thyme and rosemary. Excellent balance in the mouth, tannins are elegant and silky.

**13. Rare Vineyards Malbec,
Pays d'Oc, France**

18.65

Malbec has recently become appreciated by the discerning wine drinker looking for something a little different from the new world and Argentina in particular. However Malbec's home is in the south of France as this velvety, overtly fruity wine with violet aromas and some spice on the palate shows.

**14. El Pugil, Tempranillo Toro
Spain**

21.50

A thoroughly modern wine, made from Tempranillo grapes grown on bush vines in the Toro region in northern Spain. El Pugil throws a ripe cherry, raspberry and strawberry punch, backed by a soft creamy palate, about 15% of the blend is oak aged.

**15. Barolo, Lo Zoccolaio
Domini Villa Lanata, Italy**

46.80

The Nebbiolo vineyards of Lo Zoccolaio are situated in the village of Barolo itself. This superior selection has been matured in the traditional way for three years in large old oak barrels before bottling. A wine with great complexity and smoothness, brick red and a lingering flavour of liquorice on the palate.

**16. Pinotage NAS (no added sulphur)
Running Duck, South Africa**

19.95

Satisfying the movement towards less additives in viniculture this wine maintains decent intensity of damson and bramble fruit. Deep pink-purple colour, the palate is mid-full bodied with low acidity and a touch of tannin. **Fair trade** and **organic**. Enjoy with a very clean conscience. **Vegan**

**17. Valpolicella Classico, Superiore
Ripasso, Le Polane, Italy DOC**

26.50

Ripasso-Valpolicella which has been passed over the dried grape skins of the great Amarone wine, taking on some of its characteristics. Complex, with a fine perfume of red and black cherry, plum and notes of cinnamon and nutmeg. A step up from our previous Ripasso, this example is **classico** and **superiore**.

**18. Riserva Ducale Chianti Classico Riserva
Ruffino. Italy, DOCG**

32.85

This complex and deep red wine is characterised by sweet cherry and red berry fruit notes. Well balanced with a subtle lightness and a lingering finish of rosemary and figs.

Called 'Riserva' twice in deference to the Duke of Aosta's appreciation of its exceptional quality.

**19. Cabernet Sauvignon
Luis Felipe Edwards, Rapel Valley, Chile**

17.85

A juicy full-bodied red wine that has plenty of dark fruit on the nose, with a touch of mint and green pepper. **Vegan**

**20. Between Thorns Shiraz
South-Eastern Australia**

18.85

Fruit-driven Shiraz with aromas of cherry and raspberry, complemented by hints of spice and vanilla.

21. Rare Vineyards Pinot Noir France

19.60

The Pinot Noir grapes come from vineyards located in the south-west corner of Languedoc-Roussillon, close to the Pyrenees. The smooth, velvety palate shows cherry and blueberry flavours backed with a hint of sweet oak spice. Can be served lightly chilled.

22. Beaujolais-Villages Combe aux Jacques, Louis Jadot, France

25.35

Made with 100% Gamay grapes. The Louis Jadot cuvée comes mainly from the regions of Lantignié, Lancié and Regnié where the best Beaujolais-Villages are located, on a typical granite based soil. This Beaujolais-Villages 'Combe aux Jacques' should be drunk quite cool in order to protect the delicious aromas of fruits and the delicate freshness which is the signature of this wine.

Rosé

23. Whispering Hills White Zinfandel, California, USA

17.85

A beautiful deep salmon-pink coloured wine with loads of fresh summer fruit flavours and lively acidity.

25. Cotes de Provence Roumery Rose Chateau des Ferrages, France

29.80

Translucent, very pale pink colour with almost water like hue. Dry and possessing good textural qualities on the palate which has flavours of cherries and raspberries followed by some ripe strawberries and spice. **Vegan**

24. Vinho Verde Rose Quinta das Arcas Arca Nova. Portugal

18.50

A bright strawberry-pink rose with strawberry and raspberry aromas, complemented by a refreshing citrusy acidity, mainly lime, and a touch of *spritz* on the finish. **Vegan**

26. Ponte Pinot Grigio Ramato delle Venezie, Italy

18.95

Soft, coppery pink rosé, delicate and fruity bouquet: soft and fresh on the palate. **vegan**

Sparkling

27. Prosecco Extra Dry Treviso, Italy

23.65

Still ever popular, Prosecco is clean, dry and crisp with a creamy finish.

29. Louis Dornier et Fils Brut, Champagne, France

34.65

A light, fresh vigorously youthful Champagne with a fine, elegant, slightly lemony nose, lively mousse and long crisp palate. Outstanding value and consistently good. There is a high percentage of Pinot grapes (both Noir and Meunier) in the blend. **Vegan**

28. Taittinger, Brut Reserve NV. Champagne, France

49.65

Toasty and biscuity on the nose with a good weight of fruit in the mouth. **Vegan**

30. Prosecco Millesimato Rose Brut

23.65

Ponte, Treviso, Italy

Floral and red fruit, creamy finish; this is a light and off-dry sparkling rose.

31. Cava, Cordoniu Brut Spain

23.65

A classic dry sparkling wine. The Traditional Method of production is used with bottle-fermentation and the wine is aged on the lees for nine months. **vegan**

Dessert Wine - Go on, treat yourself !

32. Lafleur Mallet, Sauternes **37.5cl**
France, AOC **21.25**

A textbook example of elegant Sauternes, the sweetness perfectly balanced by the acidity.

34. Floralis Moscatel Oro **50cl**
Catalunya, Torres, Spain **26.80**

The Moscatel grapes are allowed to ripen and shrivel almost to raisins before pressing, resulting in a richly flavoured sweet and luscious dessert wine.

33. Vin Santo del Chianti Serelle, **37.5cl**
Ruffino, Italy **26.50**

Aromas of candied fruit and notes of honey, eucalyptus and citrus fruits.
The palate is rich and dense with a delicious sweetness in balance and a refreshing finish.
